

ARGOS COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

Argos is a K-12 single-building corporation of about 600 students with 200 in the high school. We have three gyms (high school, junior high and elementary). We have a strong FFA program, an awarded Advanced Placement program (affiliated with Notre Dame's AP TIP), and have a culture of academic excellence. One goal has been, and still is, to have the highest ISTEP scores in the county. We were one of the first two schools in the state to start playing soccer (1963) and our 1979 boys basketball Final Four team was the smallest since Milan to get to the state finals. Argos still holds the boys basketball record of 76 consecutive regular season wins, giving Argos a great sports tradition.

Argos girls basketball, under Gary Teel the last six years, had a record of 93-47, were the 2016 Class A State Runner-Up, won the 2017 Class A sectional, and finished this year 13-10 and Sectional Runner-Up (two-point loss). Graduation losses were three seniors with a total of 19 PPG average. Leading scorer 11.3 PPG (a sophomore) and fellow sophomore at 8.7 PPG return. We expect to have a competitive team next year with the addition of one of our more athletic 8th grade classes moving up.

This year, both our varsity girls and boys coaches were retired teachers. For the 2018-19 school year, we could have openings in Spanish, PE/Health, and elementary. Having a teaching position is not a requirement to coach.
